



Maxillary 2nd Bicuspid with Three Canals

- Various studies report an incidence of 1% or less in Maxillary 2nd Bicuspid
- More common in Maxillary 1st Bicuspid (incidence of 3-6%)
- Anatomy similar to maxillary molar with MB, DB and P canal orifices
- Radiographic clues include broad roots, multiple PDL's and an abrupt disappearance of canal space (known as a "fast break") in root
