



Maxillary Molar with Two Palatal Canals

- One of the rarest endodontic anomalies
- Noted in younger patients more often
- Presented case has one palatal root– with one canal orifice– splits to two canals in middle third of root – with two apical foramen
- Can also present as two palatal canals which join with one apical foramen
- A palatal groove on lingual surface of crown and root can be an indicator of an additional canal
- Must carefully examine radiographs, internal anatomy and external clues for additional canals
